

# Eyre Peninsula Secondary Alliance: Operational Guidelines

**The Eyre Peninsula Secondary Alliance is a confederation of fourteen SA government schools on Eyre Peninsula with secondary enrolments including SACE and VET courses.**

**School sites include:**

**Ceduna Area School, Streaky Bay Area School, Miltaburra Area School, Karcultaby Area School, Wudinna Area School, Elliston Area School, Lock Area School, Cleve Area School, Kimba Area School, Cowell Area School, Cummins Area School, Tumby Bay Area School Port Lincoln High School and Edward John Eyre High School**



These sites come together from different partnerships and regions of the Department for Education of SA and the work of EPSA aims to complement their current actions and strategic planning. The work of EPSA is focused on the learning opportunities and outcomes for senior secondary students

EPSA was formed to maximise the learning opportunities, career pathways, retention and educational outcomes for all secondary students in alliance schools on Eyre Peninsula.

The goals of the Alliance are to:

- 1 ensure access to and successful achievement of a range of curriculum/courses locally delivered
- 2 build the capacity of learners and teachers in their sites
- 3 optimise partnerships and communities on EP

## Organisational Matters

The alliance represented by delegates of the sites will meet regularly to review, plan and implement actions which include shared subject delivery VET or SACE, Professional Development and support, calendar planning and community event planning.

The alliance includes input from a range of regional support partners including VET pathways, Career Education, SACE support and the relevant Educational Directors and their staff and welcomes their participation at meetings.

The alliance meeting schedule and agenda will be managed by an executive of 3 site leaders

The alliance can enable committees as required to oversee relevant programs or issues that it has governance over or shared responsibility with. The current connections include:

Connection to the EWTTTC (Eyre and Western Trade Training Centre) for delivery of VET support

Local Delivery Management Committee for the shared delivery of SACE subjects between sites
